TREASURER'S REPORT

Finances

As of the end of April, we have about \$221K in reserves and \$132K in operating funds. Seven homeowners still have not paid their dues, but fortunately the last few years everyone has paid by December and we have not needed to initiate collections proceedings. If you have not yet paid and have a personal financial issue preventing it, please contact myself or another board member and we can work with you!

Cabana Work

We are currently looking into a project which will replace all of the irrigation at the cabana. Our system is very old and undocumented, so it is very expensive to maintain. This project would likely start in the fall, and be covered by reserve funds.

HOA Policies

The board has also been developing and documenting longstanding policies and procedures which helps us and future boards manage in a consistent manner. While it seems like a boring and mundane task, it's important from a legal perspective to ensure we have them. Also, we now have 106 homeowners which have provided electronic consent for certain HOA mailings. That will save us all money for routine HOA communications.



Recipe for the Grill

Foil Pack Chocolate Marshmallow Banana

INGREDIENTS

1 banana

1 handful chocolate chips

1 handful mini marshmallows

DIRECTIONS

Tear a square piece of foil that is about 12x12 inches. Place peeled banana on foil and slice it lengthwise about 3/4 of the way through. Spread it apart and fill with marshmallows and chocolate chips. Tightly wrap banana in foil.

When ready to cook, place wrapped banana on hot grill or over fire for about 5 minutes. Remove from grill, unwrap, and enjoy.
