Greetings & Salutations Belwood Homeowners,

The new year is just around the corner which means it is time again for elections. Just as in the past, there are seven (7) open vacancies for the 2024 Board of Directors pursuant to the By-laws. In addition, there will still be the same four (4) officers elected by the Board at the first meeting in January: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The slate of candidates for your 2024 Board of Directors will be set at the Board's meeting on 9/19/2023.

If you are interested in serving on the Board, you must declare your candidacy by 9/15/2023. Declaring candidacy is easy. Simply click on this <u>link</u>, fill out the Belwood BOD Candidate Application, and return it to <u>hoa@belwoodhomes.org</u> before the deadline. To be eligible to serve on the Board, you must be a Class A member in good standing (i.e., no unpaid dues). Multiple owners of one property are eligible to hold only one Board seat, and owners of multiple properties are likewise eligible to hold only one Board seat. If there is a contested election, ballots will be sent out by mail and counted at the Board meeting on 11/21/2023.

If you have any questions about serving on the Board, please contact a current Board member so we can fill you in on what to expect. Serving on the Board is a rewarding process that provides a tangible impact on our Belwood community.

Happy end of summer! I hope you were able to enjoy the pool and meet your neighbors.

I am happy to report that the state of our HOA is strong. This summer we continued to see more interest and use of our facility, as evidenced by increased numbers of after-hours keys, more swim lessons, and a full swim team roster.

Our income and expenses in 2023 have been quite close to the budget predictions made this time last year. The board has been working to prepare next year's budget and reserve study, both of which will be included in the annual disclosure statement sent to all members in October. As of press time for this issue, we are still reviewing options for a

professional HOA management company, which will influence our budgeting process and, potentially, the amount of your annual assessment.

There was a special Union School District board meeting on Friday August 25th to vote on a proposal to allow housing to be built on 1/2 of the Mirassou "AKA Mulberry School" property. The field will be replaced by 30 homes and the existing school buildings will continue to be leased to a private school.

Over 75 neighbors showed up to the special meeting to hear the board presentation and to make public comments to the board. The board did vote to proceed with the project 3:2.

Next steps will be developer Robson Homes will do neighborhood meetings and start the process with the Town of Los Gatos. The town will need to do traffic studies etc. and this project will be a long process.


