Time to Swim

Pool opens Memorial day weekend May 27th. Lifeguards will be on duty 1pm-7pm Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Open weekends only until school is out in June.

Full Lifeguards on duty starting on June 3rd until Mid August 7 days a week 1pm-7pm. Key holders can access the pool from 6am to 10pm 7 days a week.

Pool ID tags will be handed out at your first pool visit this summer. Each household will need to sign-in at the pool gate and see a lifeguard for your pool ID. Pool ID should be pinned to your swim bag and be handy if you are asked for proof of membership.



Reminder your guests cost \$3 each to swim and you need to pay cash at the pool cash box at the sign-in table.

Two New classes this year for toddlers and adults-

Little Dolphins (Level 1) This class is a Parent and me (9 months - 3 years old). An adult must be in the water with your baby/toddler. Every Tuesday @ 11:15 (\$10 Drop in)

Adult Class (New)(18+) Only Session 1, 7PM (group)

This class is for adults who want to learn how to swim who never got a chance to learn. Swimmers will learn basic swimming skills such as back floating, arm strokes, kicking while holding their breath.

- Guppies (Level 2) youngest swimmers ages 2-4
- Octopus (Level 3) basic swimming skills ages 4-6
- Otter (Level 4) continuation of skills from level 3. ages 5-7

- Frog (Level 6) introduce elementary backstroke & breaststroke ages 7-10

Many of you are aware that we are in the process of transitioning to bookkeeping firm, HOA Accounting. While we've operated more or less the same way for 58 years, we are having to change and adapt to a new way of doing business.

Did you know Belwood has a CERT (Community Emergency Resource Team)? We are looking for more members to join the team.



The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program is a nationally supported, locally implemented initiative that teaches people how to better prepare themselves for hazards that may affect their communities. Local CERT programs train and organize teams of volunteers to assist their families, neighbors, and other community members during emergencies when professional responders may not be immediately available to provide assistance. CERT offers various opportunities with you in mind.

Before, during, and after disasters, CERT volunteer teams perform basic response activities, including checking on neighbors, distributing information, supporting emergency operations centers, and helping to manage traffic and crowds. After the last storm the Belwood team drove the neighborhood checking for downed trees to report to the city via HAM radio and a GMRS/Walkie-Talkie radio. Our CERT group practices over the air communication regularly. Belwood CERT has an emergency shed at the Belwood pool facility to act as our communications hub in case of emergency.

Belwood CERT Leader Klaus has been our leader for the last eight years and is looking for a replacement, Klaus will continue assisting the new lead. Please consider joining the team.
