NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY BLOTTER

Los Gatos has been the target of a series of auto break-ins “smash and grabs” and open / garage burglaries. We hope this article acts as a friendly reminder for what we can do to help prevent crime in our neighborhood.

“Always be aware of your soundings”, words my dad, a Colonel in the US Army would echo right before he snuck up behind me and put me in a “full nelson”, grabbed my leg, or tested my “inner force”. Tough lessons for a 9 year old, but being aware of my surroundings is a concept I have kept with me since then and hope to teach to my children. I also hope to help bring awareness to our great neighborhood on how we can all help prevent crime.

“Los Gatos is a Neighborhood Watch Community and We Report all Suspicious Activity”— it’s the sign that frames our little oasis of Belwood and we need to remember that the Police encourage our help to assist them if we think that something’s not quite right.

Firstly, close your garage doors and lock your car and front doors. We’ve all been guilty of not doing it, but it’s time we make it a habit. Even if you’re just going to Walgreens or to Peete’s for a few minutes, an open door is an open invitation. The door needs to be closed and locked! Criminals are getting desperate and smart. According to the LGMSPD, *“Items stolen from vehicles generally include: lap top computers, wallets, IPODs, GPS systems, briefcases or backpacks, tools, sunglasses, items of identification, or anything that looks to be of value or possibly containing something of value.”*

Patrol Captain Dave Gravel stated that, *“Los Gatos is generally a safe community however; actions by some of the residents may be encouraging this increase in criminal activity. Theft is generally a crime of opportunity and perpetrators will often seek out those locations where they can commit the crime with little or no deterrence.”*

So, the general rule is: **bring your possessions into your house, lock your car doors, garage doors and front doors.** If you are going on vacation, tell a neighbor to keep an eye on things, don’t let papers **stack** up in the driveway, and take your garbage cans off the street (or have a friend or neighbor help out). These little things can make a big difference in deterring criminals from targeting your home.

Most importantly—if you see something or someone who seems out of place or are doing something that you think isn’t safe for our neighborhood or local park, always feel free to report them to the **LGMSPD at: 408-354-8600 (24-hour non-emergency number)**. Of course if the situation dictates, call 911.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Another great summer has passed and the kids are back to school. I hope you enjoyed the Cabana club as much as we did. The recent heat wave made me glad to have a pool in which to cool off!

The budget season is in mid-swing, and the board plans to approve the 2009 budget at the September meeting. We've done a good job managing our income and expenses, so there will be no major surprises. Once the budget is passed, we'll be sending it to homeowners in the annual package which includes the reserve study, the legal disclaimers, and other information.

Our YTD finances are looking good. Our income on a cash flow basis is over \$161K, over our annual budget. While most of our income is from dues, we have exceeded our income projections on most other line items as well with five more months left in the year. Our expenses are hitting plan, with no major surprises. We are on track to contribute at least \$24K to our reserve funds, even without taking in consideration about \$4K in interest those funds will earn in 2008. Due to a few recent bank failures, we are considering investment options to ensure we protect our funds and keep FDIC insurance on our deposits.

My 2008 priorities as treasurer are:

- Change from cash flow to accrual based accounting- Mandated by state law- COMPLETED
- Intelligently invest annual operating funds in CDs to maximize investment return- COMPLETED
- Have books audited by independent accounting firm as required by our By-Laws- IN PROCESS

As you can see, we've made a lot of headway so far this year, and expect the audit to be complete in the next month or so. The audit helps ensure proper fiscal management, and we fully expect to pass.
