As per the Bylaws, which govern our Home Owners Association, the Board of Directors address the concerns of the Cabana Club & Pool, and we have 9 elected Directors each year. TREASURER'S REPORT by Dave Klenske

Greetings all,

School is back in session, the cabana activities are starting to slow down, and the board is working hard getting things ready for next year. We're reviewing our reserve study, preparing the 2013 budget, and getting the annual mailing together. Our September meeting is where all of these are finalized for 2013. Now is a great time to attend a board meeting to learn more about how your homeowners association is run!

From a financial perspective, we successfully passed our annual financial review, performed by outside auditors. We continue tracking to budget, with no unexpected surprises. While the review is not as rigorous as an audit, it essentially tests the controls of the bookkeeping to ensure we have the money we claim we have and are spending the money in the manner we say we are.

From a reserve expenses standpoint, we've recently completed parking lot repairs and will soon be installing lights at the fence by the parking lot. This project was part of the pool deck replacement but was deferred for budgetary reasons. Because we knew we would be doing this, we are able to leverage the plans, drawings and permits pulled for the deck replacement. We chose to pull the project in a year because of uncertainty around possible new regulations and additional costs we might have to incur. We continue to contribute to the reserves as we expected to in our 2012 budget.
