Great news the pool is open!

The Pool and Cabana facility open as of July 3, at 1 PM. Due to a global chlorine shortage we have to keep the pool temperature lower than normal. We apologize for that but the only other option is to not open the pool. We chose to open the pool.

We will resume regular hours of operation. The regular rules will apply with the following addition:

- 1. All unvaccinated persons must wear a mask inside the building
- 2. If you have COVID symptoms please do not enter the facility.

We will resume renting out the facility under the regular rules and process. There is no new scheduling system.

Pool resurfacing project completed

Check out the new updated pool! The pool is looking great and ready for your return.

The pool project included the following:

- Striping of all the existing fiberglass/plaster back to original gunite shell
- Recoated the pool with 2 coats of new plaster
- Installed new wall steps at deep end grab rails
- Installed new commercial nonskid tile at racing lanes and targets.
- Installed new automatic Fill device.
- Installed commercial nonskid trim tile at shallow end entry steps.
- Installed new commercial NO DIVE deck markers.
- Installed (6) six new commercial white Pentair L.E.D. lights.

And, to help compensate for loss of use, if you have a key this year, you will receive a 50% discount on the 2022 key fee if you choose to purchase one next year. I

What is the benefit of having a key?

- 1. Use of the pool outside of lifeguard hours between 6 AM and 10 PM
- 2. Use of the pool early or late in the season, when lifeguards are not staffed
- 3. Use of the picnic area, bocce lanes, or basketball court year round

Can I join the Cabana?

Yes you can join as a Class D member for a special 50% off for the 2021 season if you live at addresses adjacent to the Class A geographic area, see the bylaws page 23 for the actual addresses allowed. All persons who are owners of record of any residence at specific addresses are eligible for Class D membership. Class D members shall have identical facility access and use privileges as Class A and C members, and shall be subject to all the same rules and regulations, except that Class D members shall not have voting rights, serve on the Board, or share in the ownership of the Corporation. Class D members are only allowed if space allows as total membership may not exceed 350 families (Class A, C, and D, combined).

Belwood local Emily Lee U.S. women's gymnasts finalist for Tokyo Olympics

18-year-old Emily Lee, her family lives in Belwood, has consistently been one of the nation's top gymnasts since making her senior debut in 2019. Emily at 6 years old started out at West Valley Gymnastics in Campbell, like lots of the local kids, but she was special. Clearly they saw the enormous potential in Emily and she spent most of her childhood in intensive gymnastic programs working toward her Olympic dream.

Emily is the 2021 Winter Cup floor exercise silver medalist and the all-around bronze medalist. She was the all-around champion at the international 2020 L'International Gymnix. Lee, who will head to UCLA next year, faced off against the best gymnasts in the country at the U.S. Olympic Gymnastics Trials in St. Louis last week.

Lee competed June 26-27th at the gymnastics finals for a spot in the Tokyo Olympics. On the second day of her Olympic bid, which took place at The Dome at America's Center in St Louis, Mo., Emily crashed to the floor during a routine and injured her ankle.

Emily placed in the finals Vault 7th place, Bars 17th place, Beam 8th place, Floor 15th place. Emily placed 15th all around for the finals, great job Emily and hope your ankle heels quickly!
