TREASURER'S REPORT

Happy Summer! A short report this month, but wanted to give you a quick update of where we are at financially. Our income and expenses are roughly in line with year to date expectations. We have approximately \$186K in reserve funds and have not needed to draw on those this year. At the end of April, our checking account balance stood at \$140K. We have had less expenses this year, primarily driven by lower legal expenses (last year we were in the middle of getting the By-Laws vote prepared) along with lower expense for repairs and landscaping. So, year over year, we're about 8% better than last year. Again, it's a snapshot in time but as has been the case for many years, we have a lot of confidence in our annual budget and responsible spending. I'm looking forward to seeing you at the many summer activities (swim team, movie nights, 4th of July Party, etc.) that are scheduled over the summer.
